£100k Platinum Wedding Dress on show at Nicholas James, Hatton Garden, London

Contemporary jewellery designer Nicholas James Fitch is hosting the first UK showing of the £100k platinum wedding dress. It forms part of a collection of 4 platinum dresses due in London for Hatton Garden Jewellery Week (6th - 13th June) and is currently on display at Nicholas James, 16-18 Hatton Garden until the end of February.

The dress is a combination of the design talents of Italian couturier Domo Adami and the ability of a Japanese artisan to weave microscopic threads of the rare metal platinum resulting in the creation of one of the world's most precious bridal gowns.

The extraordinary partnership to create this bridal gown involved patiently weaving endless amounts of microscopic platinum threads, to produce metres of this enchanting fabric. It was then handed over to the extremely talented couturier, Mauro Adami, the head of Domo Adami who used every centimetre of this precious "cloth" to design a sumptuous gown.
